USAS, SFC & ISSF rules in effect on the date of the competitions will apply. An Official Jury will be selected from the participants of each competition based on their experience and knowledge of the rules. All competitors are required to serve as flank referees.

Ammunition

(24) Gram cartridges are mandatory for both Grand Prix events. Baschieri & Pellagri (B&P) ammunition will be available for sale at fair market price. Shot size maximum is 7 ½.

Squading

All competitors will be squaded by lottery drawing for the first day of the competition. Squading for subsequent days will remain the same, but the squad start times will be altered.

Finals

A Men's & Women's "Open Finals" will be conducted upon completion of each competition regardless of residency or age as per current ISSF regulations. All resulting ties will be settled as per ISSF rules and regulations.

A, B, C & D will be established via "Euro Class" system

NORTH AMERICAN CUP CHAMPION

The top (3) cumulative scores from both the Canadian and United States Grand Prix events will be crowned North American Cup medalists. All resulting ties will be settled as per ISSF rules and regulations.

Team Events

A (2) Man Team Event will be shot concurrently on the first (150) targets of each competition. The registration cost per team is registration is \$20.00. Teams must be registered and fully paid prior to the first round of the first day of competition. A competitor may only register on one team.

Refreshments

Food and beverages will be available at the club house during the competition.

Safety

We ask that everyone please exercise the utmost care and respect for safety standards during their time both on and off the range. Both eye and ear protection are required in the range area at all times.

Range Restrictions

Animals are permitted in the parking lot area only. If the animal begins to create a disturbance, the owner will be asked to remove the animal from the immediate area. Small children are prohibited from the shooting complex unless closely supervised.

Speed Limit

The speed limit on all roads and club property is 15 MPH (25 KPH)
