**COURSE OF FIRE: Day 1 = 50 Targets / Day 2 = 50 Targets / Day 3 = 25 Targets**  
**MAXIMUM NUMBER OF SHOTS PER TARGET = 1**  
**GRAND PRIZE WINNING SCORE: 125 x 125 = World Record**
