COURSE OF FIRE: Day 1 = 50 Targets / Day 2 = 50 Targets / Day 3 = 25 Targets
MAXIMUM NUMBER OF SHOTS PER TARGET = 2
GRAND PRIZE WINNING SCORE: 125 x 125 = World Record
RULES & REGULATIONS: International Sport Shooting Federation (ISSF) (2021 Edition)

****IN EVENT OF TIES****

In the event of a tied score, a single barrel sudden death shoot-off will be conducted upon completion of the event qualification rounds. The winner of the single barrel sudden death shoot-off will win the Grand Prize vehicle.
