Rules & Regulations

USAS, ISSF & FITASC rules in effect on the date of the competitions will apply. An Official Jury will be selected from the participants based on their experience and knowledge of the rules. Competitors are required to serve as flank referees for both the Trap & Skeet events.

Range Capacity

United States Championship = September 30 – October 2 | 30 Competitors

Start Times

All competition days will commence at 09:00 SHARP, unless otherwise noted. Training days shall commence at 09:00 on an “Open” basis.

Competition Fees

\$ 250.00 | United States Championship (180 Targets) = Range Fees, Awards & Daily Lunch

Training Fees

\$ 7.00 | Olympic Trap (FO) & Olympic Skeet (OS) / 25 Targets Per Round

\$ 2.00 | Helice (EL) / Per Target

PRE-REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT ARE MANDATORY

Refund & Cancellation Policy

Keystone Shooting Park shall not issue cancellation refunds of paid registration fees, but rather offer the competitor an option to move those paid fees to another scheduled competition during the same competition season. If the competitor fails to register for another event than they shall forfeit those fees. Failure to notify management of your cancellation at least 48 hours prior to the commencement of the competition will result in forfeiture of those fees and they shall not be transferable to another event.

Reservation of Rights

Keystone Shooting Park management reserves the right to amend the conditions of this program as it deems necessary at any time.

Ammunition

(24) Gram cartridges are required for the Trap & Skeet events. (28) Gram cartridges are required for the Helice event. Ammunition will be available for sale at fair market price. Shot size maximum is 7 ½.

Firearms

Competitors must use a side-by-side shotgun, 12 gauge or smaller, hammer or hammerless.

Squading

All competitors will be squaded by lottery drawing for the first day of the competition. Squading for subsequent days will remain the same, but the squad start times will be altered.

Awards & Prizes

UNITED STATES CHAMPION

The High Over-All United States Champion awards will be presented to the top (3) combined scores accumulated from all three disciplines. The top (3) scoring competitors in each discipline (Trap, Skeet & Helice) will be presented discipline awards. Any ties will be settled as per USAS, ISSF & FITASC rules and regulations.

CLASS AWARDS

Class awards in A, B, C, D & E will be established via a “Euro Class” system.

Refreshments

Beverages will be available at the club house during the competition for a fee. Lunch will be served each day and is included in the entry fees.

Safety

We ask that everyone please exercise the utmost care and respect for safety standards during their time both on and off the range. Both eye and ear protection are required in the range area at all times.

Range Restrictions

Animals are permitted in the parking lot area only. If the animal begins to create a disturbance, the owner will be asked to remove the animal from the immediate area. Small children are prohibited from the shooting complex unless closely supervised.

Speed Limit

The speed limit on all roads and club property is 15 MPH (25 KPH)
