USAS & ISSF rules in effect on the date of the competitions will apply. An Official Jury will be selected from the participants based on their experience and knowledge of the rules. All competitors are required to serve as flank referees.

PRE-REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT ARE MANDATORY					
Refund & Cancellation Policy					
Keystone Shooting Park shall not issue cancellation refunds of paid registration fees, but rather offer the competitor an option to move those paid fees to another scheduled competition or camp during the same competition season. If the competitor fails to register for another event than they shall forfeit those fees. Failure to notify management of your cancellation at least 48 hours prior to the commencement of the competition will result in forfeiture of those fees and they shall not be transferable to another event.					
Reservation of Rights					
Keystone Shooting Park management reserves the sole right and discretion to amend the conditions of this program as it deems necessary at any time.					
Ammunition					
(24) Gram cartridges are mandatory for the Grand Prix events. Ammunition will be available for sale at fair market price. Shot size maximum is 7 ½.					
Squading					
All competitors will be squaded by known-ability within their respective categories for the first day of the competition. Squading for subsequent days will remain the same, but the squad start times will be altered.					
Refreshments					
Beverages will be available at the club house during the competition for a fee.					
Safety					
We ask that everyone please exercise the utmost care and respect for safety standards during their time on and off the range. Both eye and ear protection are required in the range area at all times.					

Range Restrictions

Animals are permitted in the parking lot area only. If the animal begins to create a disturbance, the owner will be asked to remove the animal from the immediate area. Small children are prohibited from the shooting complex unless closely supervised.

Awards & Prizes

UNITED STATES GRAND PRIX **HIGH OVERALL CHAMPION**

The top (6) scoring competitors regardless of gender, age or residency will be eligible to compete in the championship “Finals” round to determine the High Overall Grand Prix medalists. Awards will be determined on the results of the “Finals” round. All resulting ties will be settled as per USAS & ISSF rules and regulations.

UNITED STATES GRAND PRIX WOMEN’S CHAMPION

(CONTINGENT UPON REGISTRATION)

**** PLEASE READ CAREFULLY ****

Regardless of age or residency, a minimum of (8) female competitors are required to conduct a (6) person Women’s “Finals”. The resulting top (3) scoring female competitors will determine the Added Money prize winners as detailed below.

Should one or more female competitors qualify for the High Overall “Finals”, then a Women’s “Finals” will be held for the remaining top (6) female competitors in order to award the Added Money prizes as detailed below. Should there be fewer than the required (6) remaining female competitors, then the Women’s “Finals” will be cancelled. Added Money prizes will then be determined by the results of the 200 target qualification rounds. All resulting ties will be settled as per USAS & ISSF rules and regulations.

WOMEN’S HIGH OVERALL **\$3,000 ADDED MONEY AWARDS**

1st Place = \$1,300
2nd Place = \$1,000
3rd Place = \$700

UNITED STATES GRAND PRIX JUNIOR CHAMPION

(CONTINGENT UPON REGISTRATION)

The top (3) scoring Junior competitors regardless of their gender or residency will be crowned as the United States Grand Prix Junior medalists. Junior awards will be determined on the results of the 200 target qualification rounds. All resulting ties will be settled as per USAS & ISSF rules and regulations. A minimum of (6) Junior competitors are required in order to award added money prizes as detailed below.

**** A Junior Finals will be held if the Women's Finals is cancelled****

(Junior competitors must be under the age of 22, by Wednesday, December 31, 2026)

JUNIOR HIGH OVERALL \$3,000 ADDED MONEY AWARDS

1st Place = \$1,300
2nd Place = \$1,000
3rd Place = \$700

CATEGORY & CLASS AWARDS

Category & Class awards in Senior, A, B, C, D & E will be established via a "Euro Class" system.

TEAM EVENTS

A (2) Man Team Event will be shot concurrently on the first (150) targets. The cost per team member for registration is \$10.00 @. Teams must be registered and fully paid prior to the first round of the first day of competition. A competitor may only register on one team.

GOLD BULLION RAFFLE

A "Gold Bullion Raffle" will be conducted during the Grand Prix.

A one ounce Perth Mint Gold Bullion Bar will be awarded to the raffle winner.

Each registered competitor will automatically receive a single entry raffle ticket.

Additional raffle tickets can be earned during each of the (8) qualification rounds.

(23 x 25 = 1 Extra Ticket / 24 x 25 = 2 Extra Tickets / 25 x 25 = 3 Extra Tickets)

The drawing will be conducted during the Awards Ceremony on Sunday, July 5th. The drawing winner must be present to collect the prize. Additional drawings will be conducted if necessary.
